COVID-19 Information for New Hires

The health and wellbeing of our employees is important to us. For your benefit and protection, please review the following COVID-19 resources.

Vaccines:

- Effective October 1, 2021, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) requires all working within the medical center to be vaccinated.
- If you are employed by UC San Diego Health Sciences, which includes the School of Medicine, School of
 Pharmacy, or the School of Public Health, and you did NOT have a pre-employment physical, UC policy still
 requires compliance with our <u>vaccination policy</u>.

COVID Symptom Screening:

The following links may not be operable until your second day of employment, when you have access to your UCSD email and Active Directory credentials.

Daily symptom screening (every day you work, even if working remotely):

- Step #1: Click here to complete the COVID-19 symptom and exposure screening registration form.
 - You might find it helpful to complete this registration in consultation with your supervisor who can assist you complete certain fields.
- **Step #2:** Complete the Screening Survey every day you work. You may be requested to show the result prior to entering a UCSD building.
